

Add a UAH Technical Writing Intern to Your Team!

- Interns are available for **writing, editing, and document design projects**. Interns can undertake one large project, several small projects, or assist with day-to-day tasks.
- Interns are available in **Spring (Jan-April), Summer (May-July), and Fall (August-December) semesters**. Companies can review resumes and arrange the hiring process to suit their needs by evaluating one or multiple candidates through formal or informal interviews.
- Undergraduate interns work **150 hours**. Graduate interns work **100 hours** and complete a **50-hour** work-related research project.
- Intern **compensation determined by company**; interns can be paid or unpaid, though paid internship are preferred.
- Interns should **work with a company supervisor** who gives them projects and checks in on their work. The supervisor helps the intern assimilate into the company.
- Intern supervisors are responsible for **guiding interns during their work projects** and completing an evaluation at the end of the semester.
